Who are we?



Une Terre Culturelle is a non-profit association created in 2002. It is a project for sustainable human development based on mutual and continuous intercultural learning. It organises international meetings, intercultural exchanges, volunteer work and internships for young people and training for youth workers and those working in the socio-educational and cultural fields.

The association offers internships and volunteering in Marseille and its surroundings, and internationally within the framework of the Civic Service and the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) to about 150 young people per year.



Volunteering

We offer a number of volunteering and work placement schemes in a local and international contexts. All these opportunities are important to provide personal and professional skills essential for the social and professional integration of young adults. A variety of options available such as Project Management, Facilitation, Manual activities (garden) in different fields such as:

Creativity and culture, Education and training,
Employment and entrepreneurship,
Social challenges

Missions of Volunteering

Support the international mobility projects of Une Terre Culturelle

As a volunteer in Une Terre Culturelle's team, you will:

- Support our international mobility projects (intercultural youth exchange, volunteering projects and networks, internships projects, trainings) on logistical and organisational aspects
- Help the facilitation and animation of the projects with the groups of adolescents and young adults
- Help for the translation if you want and can!
- Participate and help in the animation during local events in the Maison IV and other places in Marseille. This year, Une Terre Culturelle celebrates its 30th birthday and we prepared a lot of local and international events!

For these missions, a good level of French (B1) is better, but the main criteria is motivation and engagement in our organization! The mission is of 30h/week for the volunteer. You will have 2 days of holiday per month.

What we propose to the volunteer:

- Accommodation of the volunteer in the Maison IV
- 2 weeks of trainings with other ESC volunteers during the mission, and participation in other trainings depending on the volunteer's goals and possibilities (communication, intercultural animation...)
- Tutoring to support the volunteer in its mission
- Monthly allocation (food and pocket money)
- Possibility to participate to French classes and access to the OLS platform

Missions of Volunteering

Support the activities in the Maison IV

As a volunteer in Une Terre Culturelle's team, you will:

- Participate in the maintenance of the Maison IV (gardening, small construction or reparation...). The Maison is old and needs someone motivated - don't worry, you will not be alone to do this!
- Support the development of the Maison IV as a place of local and international projects: participate and help in the animation during local events in the Maison IV and other places in Marseille. This year, Une Terre Culturelle celebrates its 30th birthday and we prepared a lot of local and international events!

For these missions, no level of French is required, the main criteria is your motivation and engagement in our organization and for the mission! The mission is of 30h/week for the volunteer. You will have 2 days of holiday per month.

Accommodation: Maison IV

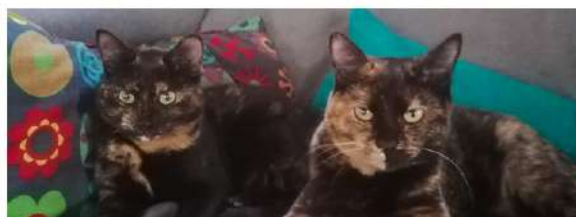
The Maison of Interculturality and Volunteering (Maison IV) is located in the 14th arrondissement of Marseille and welcomes our offices and a accommodation for international volunteers. The city centre can be reached from the Maison via the local bus and transport network. A bicycle can be provided.



The house consists of the association's offices, an activity room and, on the first floor, a flat for volunteers with :

- 4 individual rooms ;
- a living room, bathroom, toilets and a fully equipped kitchen shared with the other international volunteers
- a swimming pool (if you help on the cleaning!)

We also have a dog called Orion and two cats called Chili and Pepper!
